

A small bullseye target and scoring zones are placed around a hole using chalk or tees. Varying hitting zones are placed around the bullseye utilising different breaks, lengths and slopes. The players rotate around the tees trying to gauge the line and pace to score as many points as possible.

### Game play

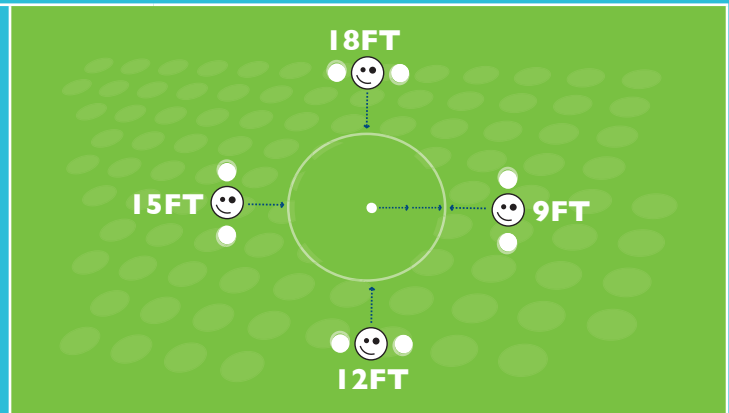
In teams each player has a set number of putts taking in turn. The teams rotate around the bullseye and keep score for each station.

### Mixed ability coaching

Vary the distances from the tee to the hole and vary the size of the scoring zones.

### Skills Test

<b>START</b>	I have putted 1/5 balls finishing in a 6 ft circle around the hole (2 putter lengths) from 9ft, 12ft, 15ft and 18ft
<b>LEARN</b>	I have putted 2/5 balls finishing in a 6 ft circle around the hole (2 putter lengths) from 9ft, 12ft, 15ft and 18ft
<b>PLAY</b>	I have putted 3/5 balls finishing in a 6 ft circle around the hole (2 putter lengths) from 9ft, 12ft, 15ft and 18ft



### Objectives

<b>START</b>	All four objectives
<b>LEARN</b>	I can use my putter and hit the ball different distances I can hit the ball off different parts of the putter face
<b>PLAY</b>	I can start the ball on the correct line when hitting a putt I can identify when a putt is uphill, downhill, sloping left, sloping right I can hit a putt using the line on my putter matching to the line on my ball
